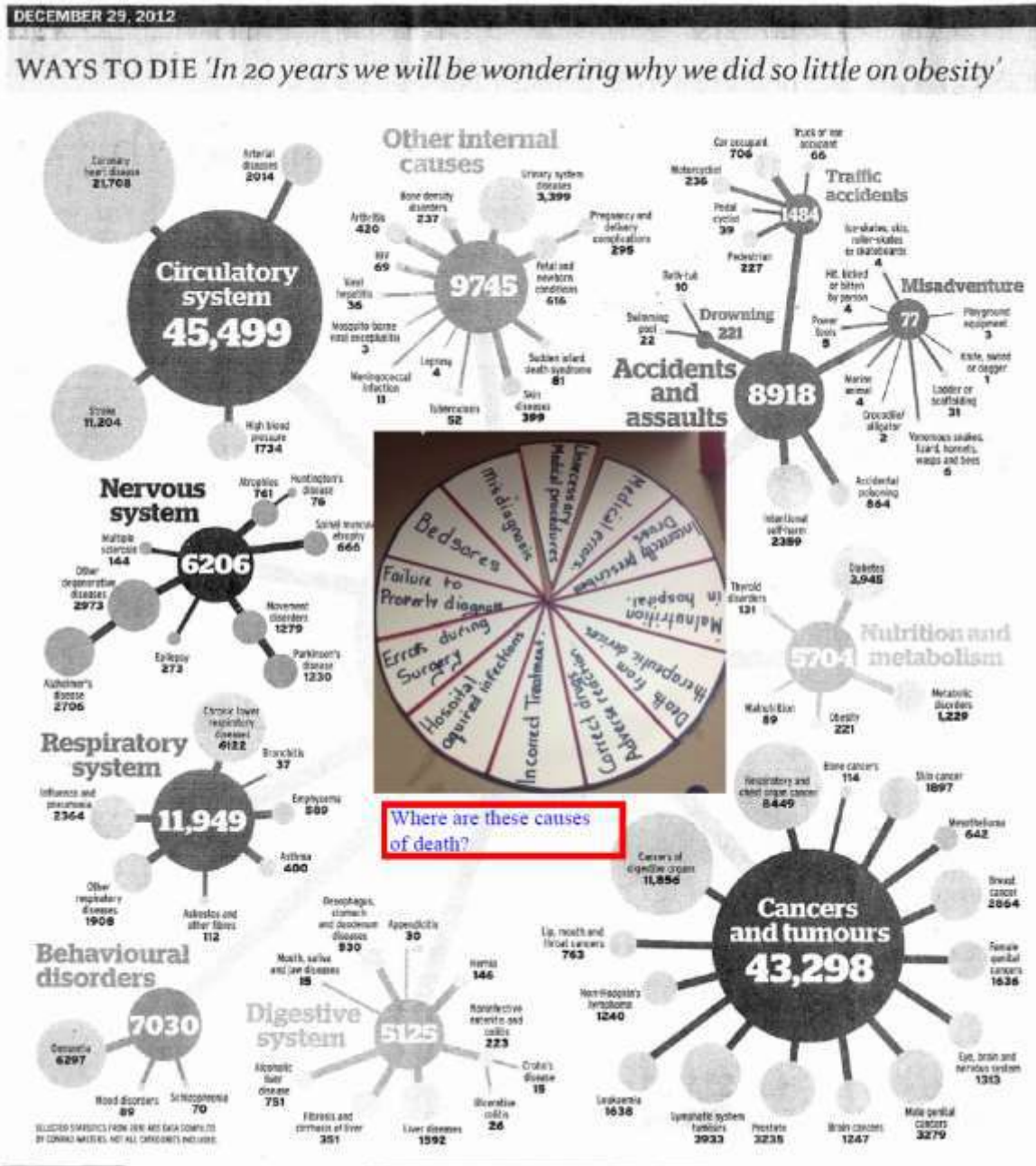


Questions in parliament confirmed a legal requirement that death certificates state the actual cause of death. The Australian Bureau of Statistics confirmed 259 iatrogenic deaths in a year. This fatal flaw in the ABS data permitted the Sydney morning Herald to publish this:



What organisation could create a set of guidelines that no country can publish its total iatrogenic toll? The WHO created a worldwide arrangement that legally permits individual declaration of the world's iatrogenic deaths to be appropriated to non-iatrogenic causes.

Governments throughout the 'developed' world use the WHO International Classification of Diseases (ICD) to harvest their data re cause of death. The structure of the ICD makes it incapable of defining a nation's iatrogenic toll.

The government sponsors, and Medicare funds public health which is the source of Australia's iatrogenic epidemic and no one can account for its toll.

The term *health Establishment* includes government, the medical profession, multinational pharmaceutical companies and the part of the media that promotes their collective interests. The trust of their end users dictates their success or failure.

Billions of dollars, the employment of probably millions of medical staff, lobbying funds for politicians, advertising for the media all rely on the deception of "first do no harm."

Oddly, protecting vested interests extends to chiropractors and chiropractic associations. No official has to my knowledge sounded an adequate forewarning to protect the health and lives of the current and future generations of victims of the iatrogenic epidemic/pandemic. Many/most chiropractors do not sound the alarm about the foregoing worldwide deadly deception.

When my patients receive an overview of this deception their average response is unenthusiastic agreement; that response is akin to telling a smoker about lung cancer.

I am sitting here with a defibrillator and a stent in my heart, a living testimony to the wonders of the bright side of medicine.
