#### Background.

The 12 categories of iatrogenesis are:

1 Adverse reactions to incorrectly prescribed drugs. 2. Adverse reactions to correctly prescribed drugs. 3. Errors (wrong site, wrong procedure, wrong patient) during surgery. 4. Medical error 5. Hospital-acquired infections 6. Bedsores 7. Malnutrition among hospitalized patients 8. Unnecessary medical procedures 9. Failure to properly diagnose 10. Misdiagnosis 11. Failure to correctly treat 12. Death arising from injury from therapeutic devices.

Dr Carmen Lawrence the then federal Minister for Health quoted a 1995 report relating to in-hospital iatrogenesis, "It is of great concern to me that between 25,000 and 30,000 people would have experienced an adverse event that resulted in some degree of permanent disability, and between 10,000 and 14,000 people would have died."

Later, the former Prime Minister Rudd's government inquiry into public health referred to only a segment of the full spectrum of iatrogenesis, stated that there are 4,550 in-hospital deaths due to medical mistakes in Australia annually.

The Australian Bureau of Statistics issues an annual report about what Australians die from. It is titled "Cause of Death". No mention was made of those somewhere between 10,000 and 14,000 in hospital deaths and Archer's 50,000 guesstimated total iatrogenic deaths.

Instead of twelve categories, the WHO's classification of diseases uses two categories permitting the statement that: "According to Causes of Death, Australia, 2007`complications of medical and surgical care' was the underlying cause of 259 deaths in 2007."

## This is how illusionists hide an epidemic/pandemic.

The world health organisation's guidelines re death certificates permits those thousands of death certificates which should bear an iatrogenic cause of death, to instead bear a non-iatrogenic cause of death.

That concealment allows the appalling reassurance that the source of the epidemic, public health is acceptably safe. Flawed ABS data denies patients accurate, true information about the magnitude of iatrogenic risk.

Illusionists within government and the media remain informed and silent about arrangements that for decades have caused an annual epidemic level of harm within public health to disappear from national statistics.

The price of concealing iatrogenic risk is obvious. If in all instances of iatrogenesis causing death those death certificates bore their true cause and accurate data was published about Australia's annual actual iatrogenic toll, tens of thousands of now dead and far more permanently harmed patients, may have sought a safer option.
