HIPAA NOTICE OF PRIVACY PRACTICES

THIS NOTICE DESCRIBES HOW MEDICAL INFORMATION ABOUT YOU MAY BE USED AND DISCLOSED AND HOW YOU CAN GET ACCESS TO THIS INFORMATION. PLEASE REVIEW IT CAREFULLY.

This Notice of Privacy describes how we may use and disclose your protected health information (PHI) to carry our treatment, payment or health care operations (TPO) for other purposes that are permitted or required by law. "Protected Health Information" is information about you, including demographic information that may identify you and that related to your past, present, or future physical or mental health or condition and related care services.

Use and Disclosures of Protected Health Information:

Your protected health information may be used and disclosed by your physician, our staff and others outside of our office that are involved in your care and treatment for the purpose of providing health care services to you, pay your health care bills, to support the operations of the physician's practice, and any other use required by law.

Treatment: We will use and disclose your protected health information to provide, coordinate, or manage your health care and any related services. This includes the coordination or management of your health care with a third party. For example, we would disclose your protected health information, as necessary, to a home health agency that provides care to you. For example, your health care information may be provided to a physician to whom you have been referred to ensure that the physician has the necessary information to diagnose or treat you.

Payment: Your protected health information will be used, as needed, to obtain payment for your health care services. For example, obtaining approval for a hospital stay may require that your relevant protected health information be disclosed to the health plan to obtain approval for the hospital admission.

Healthcare Operations: We may disclose, as needed, your protected health information in order to support the business activities of your physician's practice. These activities include, but are not limited to, quality assessment activities, employee review activities, training of medical students, licensing, marketing, and fund raising activities, and conduction or arranging for other business activities. For example, we may disclose your protected health information to medical school students that see patients at our office. In addition, we may use a sign-in sheet at the registration desk where you will be asked to sign your name and indicate your physician. We may also call you by name in the waiting room when your physician is ready to see you. We may use or disclose your protected health information, as necessary, to contact you to remind you of your appointment.

We may use or disclose your protected health information in the following situations without your authorization. These situations included as required by law, public health issues, communicable diseases, health oversight, abuse or neglect, food and drug administration requirements, legal proceedings, law enforcement, coroners, funeral directors, and organ donation. Required uses and disclosures under the law, we must make disclosures to you when required by the Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services to investigate or determine our compliance with the requirements of Section 164.500.

OTHER PERMITTED AND REQUIRED USES AND DISCLOSURES WILL BE MADE ONLY WITH YOUR CONSENT, AUTHORIZATION OR OPPORTUNITY TO OBJECT UNLESS REQUIRED BY LAW.

You may revoke this authorization, at any time, in writing, except to the extent that your physician or the physician's practice has taken an action in reliance on the use or disclosure indicated in the authorization.

FINANCIAL POLICY

FEES

Regular Chiropractic care fees may include: an exam, x-rays, and spinal adjustments. Additional fees may apply based off the doctor's discretion and may include: extra spinal or extremity adjustments, traction, manual therapy, strapping, laser, and exercises.

GROUP OR INDIVIDUAL INSURANCE

When possible, we will call to verify benefits on your insurance; however, the benefits quoted to us by your insurance company are not a guarantee of payment and are **only an estimate**. It is the patient's responsibility to know their benefits. Claim consideration by the insurance company supersedes any information quoted. Patients are fully responsible for payment of any non-covered services, deductibles, and co-pays.

SECONDARY INSURANCE

Please inform us of any secondary insurance you may have. We will bill your secondary health insurance plan as well.

MEDICARE

We do accept assignment from Medicare. The services Medicare will cover for Chiropractors is **ONLY** manual manipulation of the spine. All other services we provide are NON-COVERED. These services include, but are not limited to, x-rays, examinations, therapies, orthotics, supports, and/or nutritional supplements. **Medicare patients are fully responsible for charges of non-covered services.** Secondary insurance may or may not pay for these non-covered services. Our office completes and files the forms for Medicare at no charge.

ON THE JOB INJURY (Worker's Compensation)

If you are injured on the job, your care should be paid for under your employer's Worker's Compensation insurance. You will need to inform your employer of the accident and obtain the name and address of the carrier of their insurance. If your employer does not provide us with this information, if a settlement has not been made within 3 months, or if you suspend or terminate care, any fees and services are due immediately.

PERSONAL INJURY/ AUTOMOBILE ACCIDENTS

Please notify your auto insurance carrier of your visit to our office immediately. We will bill your med-pay auto insurance. Notify our insurance department immediately if an attorney is representing you. However, you are ultimately responsible for your bill. Once the claim is settled or if you suspend or terminate care, any fees and services are due immediately.

PATIENTS WITHOUT INSURANCE Patient is responsible for 100% of charges from each visit at the time of service. Our office offers CareCredit as an alternative payment plan. Ask receptionist for more information if this applies to you.

Payment of Account/Credit Guarantee Payment is expected at the time of service. If your account has a balance, you will receive a statement in the mail. Payment, in full, is expected within 30 day. If your account becomes 120 days past due and no payment arrangements have been made, the account will be turned over to collections. **All accounts 60 days past due from the last posted insurance payment will be assessed a 21% finance charge, with a minimum monthly charge of \$2.00.**

I have read and understand the payment policy of Ogata Chiropractic. I understand that my insurance is an arrangement between myself and my insurance company, **NOT** between Ogata Chiropractic and my insurance company. I request that Ogata Chiropractic prepare the customary forms at no charge so that I may obtain insurance benefits. I also understand that if my insurance does not respond within 60 days, or if I suspend or terminate my schedule of care as prescribed by the doctor at Ogata Chiropractic that fees will be due and payable immediately. I understand that if I do not give 24 hours notice prior to my scheduled appointment time, I may be billed for my scheduled services.

Informed Consent

Welcome to Ogata Chiropractic! We are very excited to have you here in our office. You have the right, as a patient, to be informed about the condition of your health and the recommended care and treatment to be provided so that you may make an informed decision for your care.

What is Chiropractic?

Chiropractic is a science and art which concerns itself with the relationship between structure (primarily the spine) and function (primarily the nervous system) as that relationship may effect the restoration and preservation of health.

What is Subluxation?

A vertebral subluxation is one disruption to the neurological system. This happens when one or more of the spinal column's 24 vertebrae misalign or malfunction. This results in interference with the neurological system and changes to nerve function. This could be completely asymptomatic or cause discomfort and malfunction.

How does it work?

A chiropractic adjustment reduces or corrects subluxations. The precise application of pressures to minimize or correct vertebral subluxation is called an adjustment. Dr Ogata utilizes Gonstead, Thompson, Diversified, and Cox Flex techniques to make precise spinal adjustments. Although handheld devices can be used, adjustments are typically made by hand. Rehabilitative procedures and other auxiliary procedures might also be included.

Consent To Treatment

I hereby authorize Dr Ty Ogata at Ogata Chiropractic to treat and do any necessary care that is needed for my health. This may include, but not limited to, examinations, x-rays, adjustments, laser therapy, and massage. Dr Ogata will notify me of any non-chiropractic or unexpected findings we come across while providing therapy, and will suggest that seeing another medical professional if needed.

I understand there will be a fee for all rendered services, and I am responsible for payment whether desired results are obtained or not. I understand that any care received will be billed to my insurance, if available. I understand that it is my responsibility to provide proof of coverage and to contact Ogata Chiropractic if my policy changes. I understand that I am responsible for any remaining, unpaid balance.

The benefits, risks and alternatives of chiropractic care have been explained to me to my satisfaction.
