


To set up Windows Live Mail for IMAP, perform the following steps:

1. If this is the first time that you have used Windows Live Mail, the **Add an E-mail Account** wizard will start automatically. If you already have an email account in Windows Live Mail, click the **Add e-mail account** link.
2. Enter the following information:
 - E-mail Address—Enter your entire email address (e.g., myname@mydomain.com).
 - Password—Enter the password for your email account.
 - Display Name—Enter your first and last name. This is the name that will appear in the **From** field of messages you send.
3. Click the **Next** button.
4. Enter the following information:
 - My incoming server is a—Select **IMAP**.
 - Incoming server—Enter the secure server name:
secure.emailsrvr.com
 - Select the **This server requires a secure connection (SSL)** check box.
 - Port—Ensure that **993** has been entered.
 - Login ID—Enter your entire email address (e.g., myname@mydomain.com).
 - Outgoing server—Enter the secure server name:
secure.emailsrvr.com
 - Port—Enter the secure outgoing port: **465**
 - Select the **This server requires a secure connection (SSL)** check box.

- Select the **My outgoing server requires authentication** check box.
